PRACTICAL APPLICATION

Pray for sleepy Christians, nominal Christians who aren't saved, and those not saved (esp. in the Kingman Community).

1. Make a list of all those you know who you are confident are not saved
2. Don't pray maintenance prayers for them. They may need a crisis from Christ to draw them to himself.
3. Pray extraordinary, frontline prayers:
 - a. **Request that God the Holy Spirit gift them with confession, humility to repent, and a hunger to know God.**
 - b. Pray for compassionate eyes to see the lost as sheep without a shepherd (Matt 9:36).
 - i. Those who pray for the lost see the lost.
 - c. Pray for God to burden us more about the reality of hell.
 - d. Pray that God breaks our hearts for the fate of non-believers
 - e. Pray for more laborers for the harvest (Luke 10:1-2)
 - i. Pray for the laborers now.
 1. Pray for the pastors in Kingman
 2. Pray for the revival speaker
 3. Pray for the community groups and children's church teachers.
 4. Pray churches teach the gospel accurately.
 - f. Pray for more patience, endurance, and perseverance in the harvest
 - g. Pray for boldness and courage and creativity to share the gospel
