

### Matt 24

<sup>15</sup>“So when you see

*the abomination of desolation*

- spoken about by Daniel the prophet -  
standing in the holy place  
(let the reader **understand**),

<sup>16</sup>then those in Judea must flee to the  
mountains.

<sup>17</sup>The one on the roof must not come down  
to take anything out of his house,

<sup>18</sup>and the one in the field must not turn  
back to get his cloak.

<sup>19</sup>Woe to those **who are pregnant** and to  
those who are nursing their babies in those  
days!

<sup>20</sup>Pray that your flight may not be in winter  
or on a Sabbath.

<sup>21</sup>For then there will be great suffering  
unlike anything that has happened  
from the beginning of the world  
until now,  
or ever will happen.

<sup>22</sup>And if those days had not been cut short,  
no one would be saved.

### Mark 13

<sup>14</sup>“But when you see

*the abomination of desolation*

standing where it should not be  
(let the reader **understand**),  
then those in Judea must flee to the  
mountains.

<sup>15</sup>The one on the roof must not come down  
or go inside to take anything out of his  
house.

<sup>16</sup>The one in the field must not turn back to  
get his cloak.

<sup>17</sup>Woe to those who are **pregnant** and to  
those who are nursing their babies in those  
days!

<sup>18</sup>Pray that it may not be in winter.

<sup>19</sup>For in those days there will be suffering  
unlike anything that has happened  
from the beginning of the creation that God  
created until now,  
or ever will happen.

<sup>20</sup>And if the Lord had not cut short those  
days, no one would be saved.  
**But because of the elect, whom he  
chose**, he has cut them short.

### Luke 21

<sup>20</sup>“But when you see

Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then  
know that its desolation has come near.

<sup>21</sup>Then those who are in Judea must flee to  
the mountains.

Those who are inside the city must depart.  
Those who are out in the country must not  
enter it,  
<sup>22</sup>because these are **days of  
vengeance**, to fulfill all that is written.

<sup>23</sup>Woe **to those who are pregnant** and to  
those who are nursing their babies in those  
days!

For there will be great distress on the earth

and wrath against this people.

<sup>24</sup>They will fall by the edge of the sword  
and be led away as captives among all  
nations.

Jerusalem will be trampled down by the  
Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are  
fulfilled.
