

## Daniel 9

<sup>24</sup>“**Seventy weeks** have been determined concerning your people and your holy city...

<sup>26</sup>Now after the [period of] sixty-two weeks,  
an anointed one will be cut off and have nothing.

**As for the city and the sanctuary,**

the people of the coming prince will destroy them.

But his/its end will come speedily like a flood.

Until the end of the war **that has been decreed** there will be destruction.

<sup>27</sup>He will confirm a covenant with many for one week.

But in the middle of that week

he will bring sacrifices and offerings to a halt.

On the wing of abominations will come one who destroys,  
until the decreed end is poured out on the one who destroys.”

## Daniel 11

He will turn back and direct his indignation against the holy covenant. He will return and honor those who forsake the holy covenant. <sup>31</sup> **His forces will rise up and profane the fortified sanctuary, stopping the daily sacrifice. In its place they will set up the abomination that causes desolation.** <sup>32</sup> Then with smooth words he will defile those who have rejected the covenant. ...

## Daniel 12

<sup>11</sup>From the time that the daily sacrifice is removed and the abomination that causes desolation is set in place, there are 1,290 days. <sup>12</sup>Blessed is the one who waits and attains to the 1,335 days.

## 2 Thess 2

<sup>3</sup>Let no one deceive you in any way. For that day will not arrive until the rebellion comes and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction. <sup>4</sup>He opposes *and exalts himself above every so-called god* or object of worship, and as a result *he takes his seat in God's temple, displaying himself as God....* <sup>8</sup>and then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord will destroy by the breath of his mouth and wipe out by the manifestation of his arrival. <sup>9</sup>The arrival of the lawless one will be by Satan's working with all kinds of miracles and signs and false wonders, <sup>10</sup>and with every kind of evil deception directed against those who are perishing, because they found no place in their hearts for the truth so as to be saved. <sup>11</sup>Consequently God sends on them a deluding influence so that they will believe what is false. <sup>12</sup>And so all of them who have not believed the truth but have delighted in evil will be condemned.
