

## Abomination of Desolation

**Summary:** Event that Involves a Person

*During Time of Gentiles* (Luke 21:24)

1. Surrounding of the city of Jerusalem by Gentile Armies (Luke 21:20a)
2. Jerusalem is destroyed/made desolate/made uninhabitable. (Luke 21:20b)
3. Someone or something is standing where it should not be in Jerusalem/holy place. (Mark 13:14; Matt 24:16)
  - a. A man's forces will stop the daily sacrifices (Dan 11:31; 12:11)
  - b. They will set up the abomination of desolation in place of sacrifices. (Dan 11:31; 12:11)
  - c. *"He opposes and exalts himself above every so-called god or object of worship, and as a result he takes his seat in God's temple, displaying himself as God"* – 2 Thess 2
  - d. *Then the lawless one will be revealed* 2 Thess 2:8a)
4. Jesus commands those in Judea to flee to the mountains (Mark 13:14c-18; Matt 24:16-20; Luke 21:21-22)
5. Jerusalem is overrun for a period until the time of the Gentiles is complete. (Luke 24:24b)
6. Terrible suffering in Judea/Jerusalem/fall by edge of sword (Mark 13:19; Matt 24:21; Luke 21:23b-24a)
7. The one who destroys will be destroyed at Jesus' arrival (Dan 9:27; 2 Thess 2:8)

7. The one who destroys will be destroyed at Jesus' arrival (Dan 9:27; 2 Thess 2:8)

10. “Son of destruction” (2 Thess 2:3)
11. Believes he is God (2 Thess 2:4)
12. Speaks blasphemies (Dan 7:; 2 Thess 2:4)
13. Receives Satan’s assistance (2 Thess 2:9)
14. Ability to Deceive (2 Thess 2:10)
